## ABOUT THE EXHIBITION

*Journeys | Los Angeles* is an art exhibition by photographic artist Marysa Dowling and students from Charles White Elementary School, Berendo Middle School, and Washington Irving Middle School commissioned by the Los Angeles County Museum of Art. Dowling explored questions about life in Los Angeles with students during art workshops, and journeys through schools and neighborhoods. The student chose what routes to explore, what images and objects to collect, and how to be photographed.

## IN THE GALLERY

Encourage students to describe what they see.

- What details do you notice?
- How are these photographs similar or different from the ones you have at home?
- How is this similar or different from your neighborhood?
- Write a story about a photograph. What might have happened before and after?



## PRE- AND POST-VISIT ACTIVITIES

- Draw your favorite part of the school. Combine the drawings into a large collage of the whole school.
- Create a three-dimensional sculpture of something you use everyday.
- Use everyday materials like newspapers, junk mail and flyers to create a collage about your community or Los Angeles.
