## WHO DOES THE PROGRAM SERVE?

Atter School at the Museum serves students in grades 3-I2. Students explore the museum through its artworks and collections, analyzing works of art in the gallery and making art in the studio. The curriculum is designed sequentially, with vocabulary and concepts scaffolded throughout the course of the program. Participation is open to schools from all public school districts. Enrollment is limited to 25 students.

## WHAT WILL BE OFFERED?

Atter School at the Museum brings students to LACMA one afternoon per week for eight weeks. Participation in the program includes:

- Free bus funding for all eight visits
- Student-centered gallery tours
- Hands-on studio workshops related to tours

Program activities address California State Content Standards for Visual and Performing Arts and Common Core State Standards for English/Language Arts and Literacy.

## WHAT WILL STUDENTS TAKE AWAY?

Through guided exploration of LACMA's encyclopedic collection, students will:

- Practice listening and speaking skills using works of art
- Discuss themes across cultures and time periods
- Make connections between the arts, history, and other core subjects
- Engage in the artistic process through artmaking
- Receive NexGen memberships, LACMA's free youth membership program


## WHAT IS NEEDED IN ORDER TO PARTICIPATE?

- Two hours for each afternoon visit to the museum
- The same 25 students every visit
- Field trip permission slips and photo release forms for all students
- Two adult chaperones to accompany students
- Clear communication with LACMA Coordinator
