With her husband, Steven, Mrs. Mnuchin co-chaired the Whitney Museum of American Art's Gala for two years and also co-chaired the New York Academy of Art Gala.

At LACMA, Mr. and Mrs. Mnuchin have shown past support as members of the Director's Circle and Collectors Committee, and have also attended important fundraisers including the 2012 Art + Film Gala and the Lynda and Stewart Resnick Exhibition Pavilion Opening Gala in 2010.

Professionally, Mrs. Mnuchin has had an extensive career in retail and entertainment marketing. She managed publicity for many notable films and television programs and later worked on all aspects of launching retail operations and licensing for *Sesame Street*, opening seventeen stores on the West Coast. She then served as Vice President of Marketing and Promotions for Planet Hollywood, opening over sixty sites worldwide. After Planet Hollywood, she became Senior Vice President of Corporate Communications at LAUNCH Media. When the company went public in early 1999 it was sold to Yahoo! and is now known as Yahoo! Music.
