Explore the exhibition *In Wonderland: The Surrealist Adventures of Women Artists in Mexico and the United States* with LACMA's high school interns. Through intensive training sessions, the high school interns gained knowledge about artworks and gallery teaching techniques, and they honed their public-speaking skills.

The exhibition focuses on female Surrealists who delved into their own subconscious and dreams to create extraordinary visual images, both personal and universal. Their art was primarily about identity: portraits, double portraits, couple portraits, self-portraits, self-referential images, and masquerades.

The tours of this exhibition are discussion-based, and art-making activities are incorporated into the

experience. The tours meet selected state content standards for history/social science for grades 6–12, and for visual arts for grades 5–12.

Tours will be offered on the following dates and times. Each tour lasts one hour and thirty minutes and is limited to sixty students. One adult chaperone is required for every ten students.
