


POLICIES, ACCESSIBILITY & TIPS

POLICIES

- **Photography and Video**

You are welcome to take personal photography and video in most of LACMA's galleries. Exceptions are noted with this icon  near the title of each work, or at the entry to select temporary exhibitions. Please, no flash or tripods.

- **Bag check**

For your convenience, and the safety of our artwork, we encourage you to check your bags at one of our two Ticket Offices. Bags larger than 14 1/2" wide x 8" deep X 17" long will not be permitted in the galleries and must be checked.

- **Sketching**

Sketching with pencil is permitted in the galleries unless otherwise noted. Please, no ink, paint, or easels.

- **Strollers**

You are welcome to bring your stroller into most LACMA galleries unless otherwise noted. If you prefer to leave your stroller outside, nonsecured stroller parking is provided at two locations: outside the Resnick Pavilion and near the Art of the Americas Building on the Los Angeles Times Central Court.

- **Cell phones**

Cell phones are permitted in the galleries, however, out of respect for other guests, please take conversations outside of the gallery and keep voices low.

- **Children**

We encourage children of all ages to visit LACMA, however, those under 13 years of age must be accompanied by an adult. No child may be carried upon an adult's shoulders.

ACCESSIBILITY

- **Drop off**

The most convenient location to drop off a guest who may have trouble walking is on Wilshire Boulevard.

- **Parking**

Handicap parking is available in both of LACMA's parking lots—underground off Sixth Street (one block east of Fairfax Ave) and above ground at the corner of Spaulding Avenue and Wilshire Boulevard.

- **Wheelchairs**

All of the museum's galleries are accessible by wheelchair. Wheelchairs are available at no additional expense from any of our two Ticket Offices.

- **Assisted-Listening Devices**

A limited number of listening devices are available for programs in the Bing Theater. Guests can request a device from any security officer at the event.

- **Tours**

Complimentary tours of LACMA's permanent collection are offered for guests with special needs. Applications must be submitted at least three weeks in advance.

MORE TIPS

- **Proximity to Artwork**

A good rule of thumb is to stand no closer than two feet to any work of art, unless otherwise noted or requested by a security guard.

- **Lost and Found**

LACMA's Lost and Found is located in our Ticket Office on the BP Grand Entrance.

- **Baby Feeding and Changing Tables**

Breastfeeding and bottle feeding are permitted throughout the museum. Changing tables are available in every public restroom.
