
#### **Exhibition Introduction**

Line, form, and *qi* are the fundamental components of calligraphy, a practice that has long been considered the highest form of art in China. Chinese scripts have been immensely influential, shaping writing systems in Korea, Japan, and Vietnam. The line—the most basic element of Chinese characters—defines the quality of calligraphy. The form comprises the overall composition as well as the structure of each character. There are five primary historical forms, and many new forms have been created by pioneering artists. The *qi*, a complex but significant concept, can be interpreted as life force, spirit, energy, or "the basic constituent element of the universe."


Faithful to the tradition of calligraphy but dedicated to experimentation, the thirty-four modern and contemporary artists in this exhibition explore the bounds of calligraphic art. *Line, Form, Qi* delves into the pictographic origin of Chinese characters, the relationship between writing and painting, the formal and conceptual aspects of writing, and artists' investigation and subversion of traditional calligraphic aesthetics.

Calligraphy remains an important practice within East Asia, where artists adapt the enduring art form to reflect modern life. Featuring works from the Fondation INK Collection, *Line, Form, Qi* presents the contemporary side of this rich visual art, which is both conceptual and technical, and which distinctly reflects the mental and physical state of each practicing artist.
