(Los Angeles, September 5, 2012) The Los Angeles County Museum of Art (LACMA) announced today that Grammy nominated Florence + The Machine will perform at the 2012 Art + Film Gala honoring artist Ed Ruscha and filmmaker Stanley Kubrick, the latter receiving a special tribute by Steven Spielberg. Co-chaired by actor Leonardo DiCaprio and LACMA Trustee Eva Chow, this memorable evening will take place on Saturday, October 27, 2012. Gucci generously continues to support LACMA as the presenting sponsor of this year's event. Coinciding with the gala, LACMA will highlight the 2012 Art + Film honorees in two exhibitions, Ed Ruscha: Standard (September 22, 2012-January 21, 2013) and Stanley Kubrick (November 1, 2012-June 30, 2013).

About Florence + The Machine

Led by powerful vocalist and songwriter Florence Welch, Florence + The Machine skyrocketed to international stardom with the release of their debut album, Lungs, in 2009. The album, which includes the smash hit "Dog Days are Over," reached #1 on the UK charts and #6 in the US, selling more than 3 million copies worldwide to date. The album won the coveted Brits "Best Album" award, and the band was nominated for Grammy in the category of Best New Artist.

Florence + The Machine have graced the stages of Saturday Night Live, Good Morning America, The Colbert Report, the MTV Video Music Awards, the 53rd Grammy Awards (where she performed as part of an all-girl, all-star Aretha Franklin tribute), the 83rd Academy Awards, the Met Ball, and the Nobel Peace Prize ceremony in Oslo. Time magazine ranked her at number fifty-one in their 2011 list of the one hundred most influential people in the world.

The group's second album, *Ceremonials*, was released to great acclaim in November 2011.

Art + Film Gala

All proceeds from the Art + Film Gala benefit LACMA's mission in expanding the presence of film at the museum. In recent years, LACMA has dynamically increased its curatorial programming to include film related exhibitions such as *Tim Burton*, *Dalí: Painting & Film* as well as the forthcoming

Masterworks of Expressionist Cinema: Caligari and Metropolis and the Stanley Kubrick retrospective. The museum has also seen the growth of new audiences as a result of the robust film programming led by Elvis Mitchell through the Film Independent at LACMA partnership.

The Gala Host Committee is chaired by Gucci Creative Director Frida Giannini, while the honorary committee members are outstanding patrons, visionaries, and leaders from the worlds of film, art, music, and fashion. The evening included a spectacular musical performance by the legendary Stevie Wonder as well as a special menu prepared by the renowned chef, Joachim Splichal of Patina. The inaugural Art + Film Gala raised \$3 million for the museum.
