POLICY & GUIDELINES

All events hosted at LACMA include admission to one gallery; additional charges may apply if the selected exhibition is ticketed.

LACMA's valuable art collection and exhibitions create an exciting and unique atmosphere that enhances the events in its facilities. The presence of the art and the character of the museum's programs dictate special requirements.

In order to maintain the integrity of the museum, LACMA cannot accommodate the following:

- Events of a personal nature (weddings, bar/bat mitzvahs, proms, anniversaries, etc.)
- Fundraisers and silent auctions
- Artwork display of any kind
- Marketing/branding events

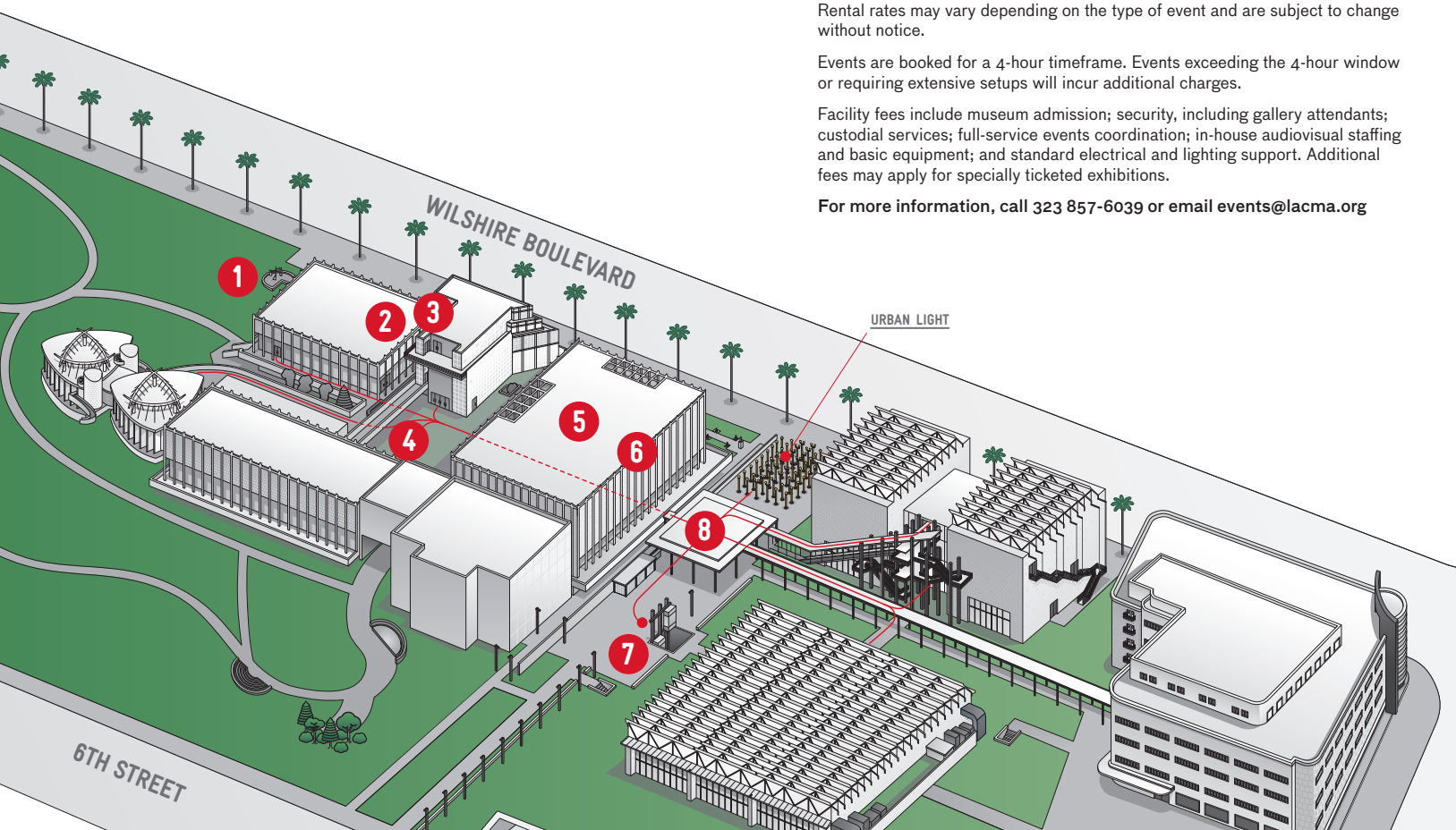
